# Medical Power of Attorney (POA)

#### **How HIPAA Works**

The HIPAA Release allows your health care provider to share information only, not make medical decisions.

#### **How Medical POA Works**

The Medical Power of Attorney allows the designated person or persons to make health care decisions on your behalf should you become unable to make decisions for yourself.

## **Things to Note**

Only your designated person or persons will be allowed to obtain medical information. They may not make any medical decisions for you.

# **Things to Note**

The agent you appoint MAY consent, refuse to consent, or withdraw consent to medical treatment.

The agent MAY also make decisions to withdraw or withhold life-sustaining treatment.

### Effective

It is effective upon signing.

#### Effective

Your agent's authority begins when your doctor certifies that you lack the capacity to make health care decisions. Unless you state otherwise, your agent has the same authority to make decisions about your health care as you would have had.

## **Duration**

It remains valid until:

- the expiration date, or
- you revoke the document in writing.

# **Duration**

A Medical POA lasts until either:

- you can make your own medical decisions,
- You revoke (cancel) it,
- You make a new Medical POA and pick a different agent, or
- the Medical POA has an expiration date.
